

SOUTH FLORAL PARK'S MIKE GODFREY ELECTED TO BOARD OF STATE'S  
VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS

G. MICHAEL (MIKE) GODFREY, A VETERAN FIRE CHIEF AND 35YEAR MEMBER OF THE SOUTH FLORAL PARK VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT IN NASSAU COUNTY, HAS BEEN ELECTED TO A FIVE-YEAR TERM ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION OF THE STATE OF N.Y. (FASNY).

AFTER PREVIOUS APPOINTMENT TO AN UNEXPIRED TERM, MIKE WAS UNANIMOUSLY ELECTED TO THE BOARD TODAY AT THE 136TH ANNUAL CONVENTION AT ROCHESTER'S CLARION HOTEL OF FASNY, "THE VOICE OF N.Y. STATE'S 100,000 VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND EMTS." HE IS A PAST PRESIDENT OF THE FIRE CHIEFS COUNCIL OF NASSAU COUNTY AND THE COUNTY'S FIRE COMMISSION AND CURRENTLY SERVES AS 1ST VICE PRESIDENT OF THE SOUTHERN N.Y. VOLUNTEER FIREMEN'S ASSN. A FASNY MEMBER SINCE 1998, HE HAS SERVED ON ITS PRESTIGIOUS FIREFIGHTER OF THE YEAR COMMITTEE.

MIKE IS RETIRED FROM THE CON EDISON CO. AFTER 29 YEARS, 15 AS A SUPERVISOR. HE AND HIS WIFE OF 55 YEARS, BARBARA, HAVE THREE DAUGHTERS.
