

VERPLANCK'S FIRE CHIEF PAUL O'BRIEN REELECTED TO BOARD OF
FIREMEN'S HOME

PAUL O'BRIEN, SERVING HIS SECOND TERM AS CHIEF OF THE VERPLANCK FIRE DEPARTMENT IN WESTCHESTER COUNTY, HAS BEEN ELECTED TO A SECOND FIVE-YEAR TERM AS A TRUSTEE OF THE FIREMEN'S HOME. THE FIREMEN'S HOME FOR RETIRED VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS IN HUDSON, N.Y., HAS BEEN MAINTAINED FOR MORE THAN A CENTURY BY THE FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION OF THE STATE OF N.Y. (FASNY), "THE VOICE OF N.Y. STATE'S 100,000 VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND EMT'S."

WITH PAUL VERY ACTIVE, THE SAME BOARD LAST YEAR DEDICATED A BRAND NEW HOTEL-STYLE HOME TO REPLACE ANTIQUATED QUARTERS WITH A STATE OF THE ART RESIDENTIAL AND MEDICAL FACILITY.

PAUL IS A 31-YEAR VETERAN FIREFIGHTER, FIRE OFFICER AND CHIEF IN THE VERPLANCK FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION AND ITS PAST PRESIDENT AND CHAIRMAN OF MANY COMMITTEES. HE CURRENTLY IS JUNIOR PAST PRESIDENT OF THE WESTCHESTER COUNTY VOLUNTEER FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION, AND PREVIOUSLY A DIRECTOR FOR NINE YEARS, AND LEADER OF KEY COMMITTEES.

HE IS ALSO ACTIVE REGIONALLY AS A VALUED MEMBER OF THE HUDSON VALLEY VOLUNTEER FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION, SERVING TWO TERMS AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS, AND ALSO AS A COUNTY VICE PRESIDENT.

AT STATE LEVEL, AS WELL AS FASNY, HE IS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE N.Y. STATE ASSOCIATION OF FIRE CHIEF, AND ADDITIONALLY, A MEMBER OF THE WESTCHESTER COUNTY CHIEFS.
