Teacher of the Year Award

Overview

The Firemen's Association of the State of New York has established this prestigious award in an effort to honor teachers in New York State whose efforts in presenting fire prevention and life safety lessons exemplify their commitment to the safety of the children they teach.

Criteria

The FASNY Fire Prevention and Life Safety Committee presents one award to a teacher at the elementary or secondary level, currently teaching in a public, private or parochial school in New York State. This teacher clearly demonstrates a commitment to the instructional process of fire prevention and life safety education.

Criteria have been set as a guideline for this award. They include:

- Active participation in FASNY's Fire Prevention and Life Safety Essay Contest and Fire Prevention and Life Safety Poster Contest and in programs such as the Team New York Risk Watch Initiative.
- Instructional strategies that emphasize fire prevention and life safety and the use of New York State's volunteer firefighters in this effort.
- Creative ways of introducing fire prevention and life safety into the school and classroom.

These criteria are not intended to be all inclusive. Other qualifications may be considered if the committee feels they meet the intent of this award.

Nominations

Nominations for the Teacher of the Year Award may be submitted by a fire company, fire department, county fire association, sectional fire association, school principal or school administrator.

Nominations must be received by the Fire Prevention and Life Safety Committee by February 28th.

Unsuccessful nominations will be retained and reviewed for a period of three years from the date submitted. Letters of support and any other supporting material accompanying the nomination will become the property of FASNY.

The award winner will be notified by May 1st.

The presentation of this award will be made at a local ceremony.
