

Important Hazardous Material Statement

Class B Aqueous Film Forming Foam (AFFF)



As of April 25th 2017, all New York State Fire Departments are **no longer allowed to use Class B AFFF (Aqueous Film Forming Foam)** that contain the following chemicals:

- Perfluorooctanoic Acid (**PFOA– Acid**)
- Ammonium Perfluorooctanoate (**PFOA-salt**)
- Perfluorooctane sulfonic acid (**PFOS-Acid**)
- Perfluorooctane Sulfonate (**PFOS- salt**)



If you think you may have Class B AFFF in your station here are **several steps you need to take:**

- Remove all products from service
- Secure all products in secure containers to prevent accidental spills
- Contact a Hazardous Waste Disposal company to properly dispose of the foam.
