

OCTOBER FIRE PREVENTION WEEK CURRICULUM

- Day 1 Prepare lesson to describe home hazards. Include work to send home to have parents and children identify safety hazards in their own home.
- Day 2 Teach children about what smoke can do and about smoke alarms. Send request home with children to have parents and children test smoke alarms, where they are located and when batteries were changed.
- Day 3 Teach EDITH in class. Draw classroom and school maps. Homework for parents and children to draw map of home and discuss exit plans for home. Return plans & maps to school.
- Day 4 Teach and practice meeting places at school, importance so parents know where they are if fire, don't go back in. Homework is for parents and children to plan and practice meeting places at home. Draw picture to describe home meeting place.
- Day 5 Don't fear and hide from a firefighter. Have a firefighter take gear, SCBA, and tools to classroom. Dress up and have demonstrations for all grades.
